GOLDEN OLDIES LAWS





All players must be correctly attired for Golden Oldies Rugby, including footwear - (low profile stud football boots or grass sport shoes). These Golden Oldies rules do not permit offside play, unsportsmanlike behaviour and are designed to increase enjoyment of the game while eliminating over-vigorous play and minimising the chance of injury.



A player wearing **white shorts** can be tackled to the ground or pushed off their feet. Any player in red shorts may be "held" but NOT tackled. The player can be claimed or held by wrapping arms around the body to prevent further forward movement, but they must not be thrown to the ground and they must be able to free the ball to play it. In other words, you can hold them but do not tackle them.

A player wearing **red shorts** can not be tackled to the ground or pushed off their feet. Any player in red shorts may be "held" but NOT tackled. The player can be claimed or held by wrapping arms around the body to prevent further forward movement, but they must not be thrown to the ground and they must be able to free the ball to play it. In other words, you can hold them but do not tackle them.








Players wearing **gold**, **purple**, **or special festival committee shorts** may travel up to 10 metres with the ball before releasing

60 - 64 years (Red shorts) - can be claimed, not tackled



65 - 69 years (Gold shorts) -Not to be tackled









THE SPIRIT OF GOLDEN OLDIES, EPITOMISED IN THE MOTTO OF FUN, FRIENDSHIP, AND FRATERNITY.

The laws of Rugby as per the international Rugby Board shall apply with the following variations;

- 1. The game time can be set according to the competition requirements but are generally three 20-minute periods. Other variations can be organised at the discretion of both captains.
- 2. There is to be no 'cleaning out' around the rucks and mauls.
- 3. All 8 forwards must remian bound in the scrum until the ball has been cleared.
- 4. There shall be no striking against the head by the hookers or front row. There must be no pressure in scrummaging or movement of the scrum.
- 5. The half back must not follow the ball around the scrum
- 6. From a penalty there shall be no quick tap and all players shall retire 10 metres.
- 7. Players must observe the offside rule, particulary that of remaining behind the hindmost foot rule at rucks and mauls.
- 8. Players are to be onside and observe the 5 metre rule at scrums and 10 metres at lineouts
- 9. Unlimited substitution of players and substituted players may return for injured players.
- 10. Teams scoring a try shall also restart the game by kicking the ball to the non-scoring team.
- 11. In lineouts, all 8 forwards must take part. There shall be no supporting in the lineout. All lineouts shall be set (no quick lineouts)
- 12. Players may kick the ball only in their own 22. Sanction of a free kick at other times.
- 13. Coloured shirts; All players are to observe the restrictions of tackling older players.
